- **NEW SIZE REQUIREMENT** Poster Size **MUST BE 14"x22"** (1/2 poster board)
- The 2018 poster title "Watersheds - Our Water, Our Home" must be on your poster.
- Poster must be **FLAT** (not three-dimensional)
- Entries completed by students in their own handwriting and coloring will score better than those designed, drawn and colored with adult assistance.
- A completed and signed 2018 "Watersheds - Our Water, Our Home" Entry Form must be attached to the back of the poster to make it eligible for judging.
- All posters must be completed by individuals, not by a team, and turned in to your local SWCD for judging by their deadline.
